**Subject: AUSEEDER – SECOND ACCUMULATOR OPTION**

All Auseeder bars are fitted with an Hydraulic Accumulator to allow tine breakout on hitting obstructions. Accumulator capacity has been increased progressively, as bar sizes have increased, and the standard size is now 20 litres.

In relatively clean soils, this capacity has been satisfactory for most bars. In very rocky soils, where there is the possibility of multiple tines tripping simultaneously, some extra capacity has proved beneficial. This has been achieved by installing a second accumulator unit, connected in parallel with the original unit.

The second accumulator will be fitted as a standard feature on all wide centre frame models (48E – 70) from the 2008/09 season. It will remain available as an option, for all narrow centre frame models, and as a kit for fitment to any machine already in the field.

Kits are available in two versions;

The accumulator, with associated fittings, U-Bolts and support brackets, is identical in both kits. The only difference in the kits is the addition of an “L” shaped mounting stand and U-Bolts, to allow the extra accumulator to be mounted directly above the original.

The basic kit can be used on any bar that has sufficient space for a second unit to be mounted on the main frame in the same manner as the original.

The high-mount kit will be used in production on all 260mm spacing models, and on 300mm spacing models with narrow centre frames.

## **PARTS BULLETIN No. 7-08 – Issue 2**

### **Subject: AUSEEDER – SECOND ACCUMULATOR OPTION – TIMING FOR INTRODUCTION**

The information contained in the original issue of this bulletin is generally correct.

There may, however, be some confusion over the exact timing of its introduction as a standard feature on the larger wide centre frame bars.

The Bulletin said; “The second accumulator will be fitted as a standard feature on all wide centre frame models (48E – 70) from the 2008/09 season. It will remain available as an option, for all narrow centre frame models, and as a kit for fitment to any machine already in the field.”

It should also have said that standard fitment would apply only to machines ordered from the Machinery Price List issued in July 2008. This Price List includes the Second Accumulator in the relevant machine specifications and these machines are priced accordingly.

Any machine supplied against an early order and priced from earlier Price Lists, will have the Second Accumulator as an Extra Cost Option if required. This also means that some wide centre frame machines, supplied against early orders for the 2008/09 season, will not have a second accumulator fitted as the customer has not ordered the option.
